



IMPORTANT WORK ON YOUR WATER SUPPLY

Seqwater is undertaking a \$1.5 million upgrade on its water network.

As part of this, Seqwater is carrying out works on two pipes that supply water to Brisbane and Ipswich.

This work will continue this weekend and there may be some temporary impacts on your water supply.

When will the work occur?

Stage one and two of works have been carried out. Additional works will be undertaken from **Saturday 31 July to Sunday 1 August.**

What to expect

You may experience lower or fluctuating water pressure or temporary discolouration of water. Your water remains safe to drink.

Tankers and booster pumps will help supplement water supply in parts of western Brisbane. These will be at various locations in your area to keep the water flowing.

Some residents may experience increased noise, including overnight on Saturday, during tanker and pump operation. Parking may be restricted in some areas, but local access will remain.

Temporary water outage

Some properties will experience a **short, temporary water outage** while tankers and pumps are being connected and disconnected.

Building Managers: we recommend contacting the relevant fire and equipment service provider for advice about preparing your building systems before the potential pressure reduction.

What you can do

Just like preparing for storm season, store some water in containers to cover you if you do lose water.
