

Working beneath the streets

Juliette and Peach Street, Greenslopes

June 2022

You can rely on us to keep things flowing, and from time-to-time we need to upgrade your local water network.

About the project

Our delivery partner, Downer WSP, will soon start work on replacing sections of water pipes along Peach Street and Juliette Street, Greenslopes. Construction will start on Wednesday 13 July 2022 and take approximately 10 weeks to complete, weather and site conditions permitting.





Why is this happening?

The pipes are reaching the end of their service life. Upgrades to the water network will ensure that we can keep moving the water to your taps.

Project delivery and work hours

The work will be delivered in partnership with Downer WSP and their subcontractor **Interflow PTY LTD**.

Most of the work along Peach Street will be completed during the day, between 6.30am and 6pm, Monday to Friday. Construction on Juliette Street will be carried out at **night**, between 7pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday.

Night work is required during water outages, while we connect to the water main and to comply with approved traffic permits. Traffic controllers may arrive onsite earlier to prepare for the day / night activities. We will notify you in advance when night works are planned.

What to expect during construction?

During construction, nearby residents and businesses may experience noise and dust from machinery, increased vehicle movements and minor vibration during excavation activities. Well minimise this where we can.

Works will begin at the Ridge Street intersection, progressing along Peach Street towards Dunellan Street and concluding at Juliette Street, Greenslopes.

Water Outages

We'll give you at least three days' notice before any planned water interruptions to your water supply. Keep a look out in your letterbox for these updates.

Temporary water service (bypass pipe)

Your property may be connected to a temporary water service pipe to maintain your water supply. The temporary pipe is usually laid across driveways, a crossing ramp will be used to maintain safe vehicle access and to protect the pipe. We recommend that you cross the ramp at a slow speed without stopping to avoid damaging it. This temporary water supply is the same quality of drinking water as your normal service; however, you may notice a slight reduction in water pressure.

Tree pruning / removal

Some trees might be identified for pruning or removal at worksites. Any trees marked with an "R" will be removed in accordance with council permit and replaced in approved areas following project completion.

Temporary work sites and holding area's

Temporary holding areas will be located along Peach Street, Greenslopes. These areas will be used to store pipe, materials and machinery. Barriers and signage around work areas will be in place to keep everyone safe.

How will impacts be managed?

Downer WSP and our contractors will minimise the construction impacts to the extent possible, including managing noise and dust at





the source and reviewing work methods as required.

Changed traffic conditions will be in place around work areas with possible road, lane and footpath closures. Traffic control will manage the flow of traffic, ensure pedestrian safety and maintain local access.

Please take care and observe all signposting, speed limits and any directions given by traffic controllers.

Restoration

Temporary restoration will occur while work is in progress. At completion, we'll restore as close to the original condition as possible including roads, driveways, footpaths and nature strips that have been impacted by our works.

Our commitment

We will keep directly impacted neighbours informed by providing regular construction updates during the project.
