





WATER TANKER: ON YOUR STREET

Segwater is undertaking a \$1.5 million upgrade on its water supply pipe network.

As part of this maintenance project, work will be undertaken on two pipes that supply water to Brisbane and Ipswich. This work may have some temporary impacts on your water supply.

COVID-19 IMPACT*

Stage two of the project was postponed due to the recent COVID-19 lockdown.

This work is now planned to take place on Saturday 17 July to Monday 19 July, however these dates are subject to change depending on the situation.

What to expect

Seqwater and Urban Utilities are working closely to ensure water supply is maintained to your property during the work. Stage one of the works was successfully completed in June. Stage two will again involve supplying water from different areas of the network using water tanker trucks. These tankers will connect to the local network to keep the water flowing to your taps.

From **Saturday 17 July to Monday 19 July 2021** (*refer overleaf), the tankers will be stationed at various locations in your area. You may expect some noise during operation of the tanker. Parking may be restricted in some areas, but local access will always be maintained.

No loss of water should occur. If you do experience a complete loss of water, please report this to our Faults and Emergencies line on **13 23 64**.
