

Project Update: Rowena Street and Moggill Road, Kenmore

What's happening?

Our delivery partner, Downer WSP and their subcontractors, are now in the process of replacing sections of sewer pipe near Moggill Creek in Rowena Street Park, between Rowena Street and Moggill Road, Kenmore.

We recently let you know that the footpath access between **Rowena Street** and **Moggill Road, Kenmore** will be temporarily unavailable for **up to three months**. This decision has been made to ensure the safety of our pedestrians and workers, while we complete essential works to remove and install the new pipe.

We understand that this walkway is often used for access to Kenmore State School, the Moggill Road bus route and the local dog off-leash area. The dog park can be accessed from Moggill Road, Kenmore during this time. The walkway between Wyndarra Street and Moggill Road, Kenmore will remain open.

We are currently exploring alternative options to minimise the impact of this closure on the community. We'll keep you up to date as the project progresses.

Work hours: Monday to Friday between 6:30am and 6:30pm, weather and site conditions permitting.



The project team will manage the construction impacts by minimising noise and dust wherever possible and placing barriers and signage around the work area.
