





WATER BOOSTER PUMPS ON YOUR STREET

Segwater is undertaking a \$1.5 million upgrade on its water supply pipe network.

As part of this maintenance project, work will be undertaken on two pipes that supply water to Brisbane and Ipswich. This work may have some temporary impacts on your water supply.

Segwater is the bulk water supplier in South East Oueensland and Urban Utilities is responsible for delivering this treated water to homes and businesses.

Ensuring the long-term sustainability of your water network.

What to expect

Seqwater and Urban Utilities are working closely to ensure water supply is maintained to your property during the work. Stage one of the works was successfully completed earlier this month, and Stage two will involve supplying water from different areas of the network using water booster pumps. This time, we'll be connecting water booster pumps to the local network to keep the water flowing to your taps.

From **Thursday 1 July to Monday 5 July 2021**, the pumps will be stationed at various locations in your area. You may expect some noise during the operation. Parking may be restricted in some areas, but local access will always be maintained.

A temporary water outage is required for the connection and disconnection of the pumps. Properties affected by the outage have been notified.
